crochet pattern



materials & tools

- Yarn: DK/100% Cotton
 - For green leaf lettuce:
 - Rowan Handknit DK: GOOSBERRY
 - Rowan Handknit DK: BLEACHED
 - For red leaf lettuce, add:
 - Rowan Handknit DK: RASPBERRY
- Hook: 3.00 mm
- Tapestry Needle
- Stitch Markers
- Scissors

abbreviations

This pattern is written in US terms

ch	chain
st	stitch
sc	single crochet
hdc	half double crochet
dc	double crochet
(...) x	repeat instructions indicated number of times
[...]	total stitches in round

size: 11 in. x 4 in.

pattern notes

- 01 Size:** Gauge doesn't matter! I have included the size of the finished toy based on my yarn weight and hook size, but if you want yours bigger just use a bigger yarn and hook.
- 02 Yarn:** Take your choice of yarn! Choose colors and fibers that bring you joy. I use 100% cotton yarn because I make these toys for my kids and need them to be natural, washable, durable & soft.
- 03 Color Options:** You can make red leaf, green leaf or both! Green leaf uses white and Goosberry. Red leaf uses those two, plus Raspberry.
- 04 Special Stitches:** This pattern uses basic stitches only. You can find video tutorials of these and several others on my website if you need help!

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leaf

The leaf begins with a chain and a row worked back into the chain. Then, the rows are worked on both sides of the chain, turning at the bottom of the leaf each time (versus working in continuous rounds around the chain).

Start in white:

Rnd 1: ch 31, sc in 2nd chain from hk and each thereafter [30]

Switch to Gooseberry (green):

Rnd 2: ch 1, turn, sc in next 5 st, hdc in next 5 st, dc in next 19 st, (make 3 dc in next st) x2, dc in next 19 st, hdc in next 5 st, sc in next 5 st **PHOTO 01**

If making red leaf lettuce, switch to Raspberry (red), otherwise continue with green:

Rnd 3: ch 1, turn, sc in next 5 st, hdc in next 5 st, dc in next 19 st, (make 2 dc in next st) x2, (make 3 dc in next st) x2, (make 2 dc in next st) x2, dc in next 19 st, hdc in next 5 st, sc in next 5 st

Rnd 4: ch 1, turn, sc in next 15 st, dc in next 17 st, (make 2 dc in next st) x2, (make 3 dc in next st) x4, (make 2 dc in next st) x2, dc in next 17 st, sc in next 15 st **PHOTO 02**

Rnd 5: ch 1, turn, sc in next 20 st, (make 2 dc in next st) x44, sc in next 20 st **PHOTO 03**

Rnd 6: ch 1, turn, sc in next 20 st, (make 2 dc in next st) x88, sc in next 20 st [216] **PHOTOS 04, 05 & 06**

Fasten off. Weave in ends.
